Dr. Dale W. Meyerrose, Major General, U.S. Air Force retired, is an international, preeminent technology and cybersecurity strategist. As president of the MeyerRose Group, he consults with business, government, and academic organizations on strategy, digital transformation, telemedicine technologies, cybersecurity, and executive leadership. He is a partner of *RIDGE-LANE Limited Partners*, a merchant-bank founded by financier R. Brad Lane and The Honorable Thomas J. Ridge, former Governor of Pennsylvania and first Secretary of U.S. Department of Homeland Security. He is an adjunct professor at Carnegie Mellon University, where he runs one of the very few cybersecurity leadership certificate programs in the Country.

Dr. Meyerrose is an adjunct contract professor for the United States Air Force. He is Chairman of the Board for Imcon International, Inc. and on the Board of Directors/Advisors of multiple other American and International corporations. He is also a Trustee and the Treasurer for the U.S. Air Force Academy Falcon Foundation.

Dr. Meyerrose was the first President-appointed, U.S. Senate-confirmed chief information officer for the U.S. Intelligence Community when it reorganized in 2005. Just prior to that, Dr. Meyerrose spent over 30 years forging a highly decorated career in the U.S. Air Force as a difference-maker whose innovation, skill, and commitment produced an enviable record of accomplishment.
