<b>Session Rooms</b>	Heritage Ballroom, Fremont Room, & Carson Room <i>All speaker rooms are on the lobby level</i>
<b>Directions</b>	From the North: Follow I-25 S to exit 142 (Bijou St). Turn left heading east for 1/2 mile. At 2nd light, Cascade Ave, turn right (S). Entrance to the hotel is 2 blocks on the right.  From the South: Follow I-25 N to exit 142 (Bijou St). Turn right heading east for 1/2 mile. At 1st light, Cascade Ave, turn right (S). Entrance to the hotel is 2 blocks on the right.
<b>Parking</b>	<b>Overnight guests with reservations: \$19.00 per night</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Upon arrival, <b>guests should note their license plate number and the state that issued it</b> and provide this information to the front desk at check-in. Our team will then issue a parking pass with in-and-out privileges valid from check-in through check-out</li></ul> <b>Local guest / day guests (no overnight reservation): No Fee</b> Day guests may validate parking in one of the following ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A tablet will be available at the group's registration desk. Attendees will select "Validate," <b>enter their license plate number</b>, and submit. A green confirmation box will appear once the process is complete.</li><li>Or they can <b>provide their license plate number</b> to the front desk and let them know they are with Peak Cyber Symposium as a day guest and need to validate parking.</li><li><b>Note:</b> For day guest only each time they exit and re-enter the parking garage they will need to revalidate their parking before leaving again.</li></ul>
