Colonel Wingo previously served as the Director of Cyber & Spectrum Operations Integration at HQ US Space Force, leading the Service Staff support of Defensive Cyber Operations, Cybersecurity, Electromagnetic Spectrum Operations, and SATCOM management for the United States Space Force.

Colonel Wingo was commissioned through the Officer Training School in January 1999. He commanded the 39th Information Operations Squadron, the 628th Communications Squadron, and the 690th Network Support Squadron Det 2. Additionally, he has served in a broad variety of leadership and instructor assignments.
