Dr. Dale W. Meyerrose Major General, U.S. Air Force (retired) | President, MeyerRose Group

Dale Meyerrose, Major General, U.S. Air Force (retired), Doctor of Professional Studies, is President of the MeyerRose Group, LLC. He is an internationally respected thought leader on change leadership, cyber and cybersecurity, information technology, and military matters. He's been cited in a dozen books, annually speaks to several government, corporate, and academic audiences, and authored over 150 articles for national and international newspapers, professional journals, and publications. Meyerrose lectured at some twenty universities and assisted two in establishing credentialed and degree programs for information and cyber security disciplines. He is also President and Chairman of the Board for Imcon International, a technology company, which sells digital services internationally, specializing in remote and rural areas. Imcon has been instrumental in restoring digital services to areas hit by disasters, such as when western North Carolina was hit by Hurricane Helene in 2024.

General Meyerrose has served on multiple university faculties, has been an Adjunct Contract Professor for the U.S. Air Force, and served on multiple boards of directors. General Meyerrose, a Southwest Asia veteran, was the first President-appointed, U.S. Senate-confirmed Chief Information Officer for the U.S. Intelligence Community after serving three-plus decades of decorated military service.

General Meyerrose graduated from the U.S. Air Force Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree in economics and from the University of Utah with a master's degree in business administration. He earned a Doctor of Professional Studies in Information Management from Syracuse University, where his award-winning research focused on introducing new technologies to telemedicine. He graduated from the National War College and attended senior executive programs at: National Defense University in Washington, DC; Air University at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama; Harvard's John F. Kennedy School of Government; University of California at Berkeley Haas School of Business; and the University of Virginia Darden School of Business. General Meyerrose has been inducted into five Halls of Fame (including ISSA) and honored with eleven lifetime achievement awards by various national, professional associations.
